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# The Casting On Couch

## Plaited Cable scarf

Use a Chunky yarn that recommends on the ball band, a needle size ranging from 8 to 10mm. Expect to purchase between 10-12, 50g balls of yarn. The yarn useage is approximate and may vary depending upon your choice of yarn.

Note this scarf has a selvedge already included (2sts per side in garter stitch). The approximate finished width of the scarf when knitted in pattern is 38cm/15inches. There are 3 cables to complete across the width of this scarf.

This repeat works in sections of 13sts and 8 rows.

Cast on 43 sts.

## Main Pattern

**Row 1:** K2, p2, (k9, p4)x 2, k9, p2, k2 *Right side*

**Row 2:** \* K4, p9 rep \* ending k4. *Note all wrong side rows are as row 2.*

**Row 3:** K2, p2, (cf6, k3, p4) x 2, cf6, k3, p2, k2

**Row 5:** As row 1.

**Row 7:** K2, p2, (k3, cb6, p4) x 2, k3, cb6, p2, k2

**Row 8:** As row 2 and the last row of the repeat.

Repeat rows 1 to 8 until your scarf is the desired length.

## Abbreviations

**Sts-** stitches

**k2-** knit 2

**P2-** purl 2

**(k9, p4)x 2-** knit 9, purl 4, knit 9, purl 4

**rep \*-** repeat sequence throughout row from \* to rep\*

**Cf6-** Slip 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold them in the front of your work. K3 then proceed to k3 from the cable needle.

**Cb6-** Slip 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold them in the back of your work. K3 then proceed to k3 from the cable needle.
