

## BEGINNERS GUIDE TO RASPBERRY OR TRINITY STITCH

This stitch works in multiples of 4st and 4 rows.

This means you can cast on any multiple of 4sts and the pattern will work. By repeating the four rows over and over again, you begin to build up this beautiful lace bobble pattern.

### MATERIALS

Freedom Wool, by Twilleys of Stamford, colour 435.

Set of 10mm needles.

### BEGIN

Cast on a multiple of 4 sts. (In the video I cast on 16sts with 10mm needles).

Row 1: Purl to end. Right side.

Row 2: \* KPK into next st, p3tog, rep \* to end.

Row 3: Purl to end.

Row 4: \* p3tog, KPK into next st, rep \* to end.

Repeat rows 1 to 4 as required.

### ABBREVIATIONS

P3tog - Purl three stitches together.

KPK - Create three stitches from one by knitting, then purling, then knitting all into the next stitch.

Rep \* to end - Repeat the knitting stitch sequence from \* to rep \* over and over again as directed.

St(s) - Stitch or stitches.
